It may seem obvious, but one of the first things you'll need to do is conduct a visual inspection of the area in and around your construction equipment.

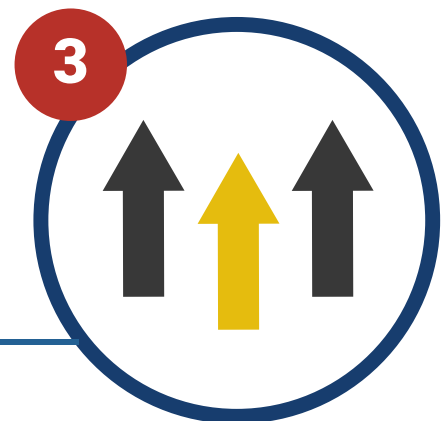


STABILIZE THE ZONE OF YOUR EQUIPMENT

In stabilizing the zone of your equipment, you'll want to go ahead and begin making sure that the outriggers are fully deployed and developed.

ENSURE LIFTS MEET THE LIFT CRITERIA

As anyone working in construction knows, the lift criteria changes depending on what you are trying to accomplish with your lift and the overarching project.



SECURE THE LOAD POST-LIFT

This is another no-brainer for anyone who has experience operating a crane lift, but in short you should be especially mindful to select the proper rigging for the load you are lifting before you lift it.
